

Secret intern telegram, in which is reported about the rescue of 270 Jewish children from Hungary and requested to prevent by all means further transports of Jewish children from Nazi Germany to Erez Israel, Berlin 1943

Berlin, 11 March, 1943

Referring to decree by telegram no 717 dated March 1943 it is requested that an attempt be made to prevent transport of Jewish children to Palestine.

D III 926 Reminder

According to Press reports from Antyca 72 Jewish children from Hungary who have been shipped to Palestine via Rumania, Bulgaria and Turkey by the British are supposed to have arrived in the Camp of Athlit in Palestine. Allegedly this is part of the transports of 270 Jewish children from Hungary and Rumania which were announced in the British House of Commons. According to reports of the Palestine Press this number is supposed to be increased to 500.

Please do you utmost to prevent emigration and transit shipments of Jews to Palestine and report about results.
