



Frank, Karl Hermann

(1898--1946), Deputy leader of the Sudetenland after the Munich Conference of 1938 and virtual leader of the Protectorate of Bohemia and Moravia from 1943. In these posts Frank persecuted Czech Jewry. At the end of the war he fled to the West, but the Americans extradited him to Czechoslovakia, where a Czech court sentenced him to death. He was executed by public hanging. (see also Bohemia and Moravia, Protectorate of.)
